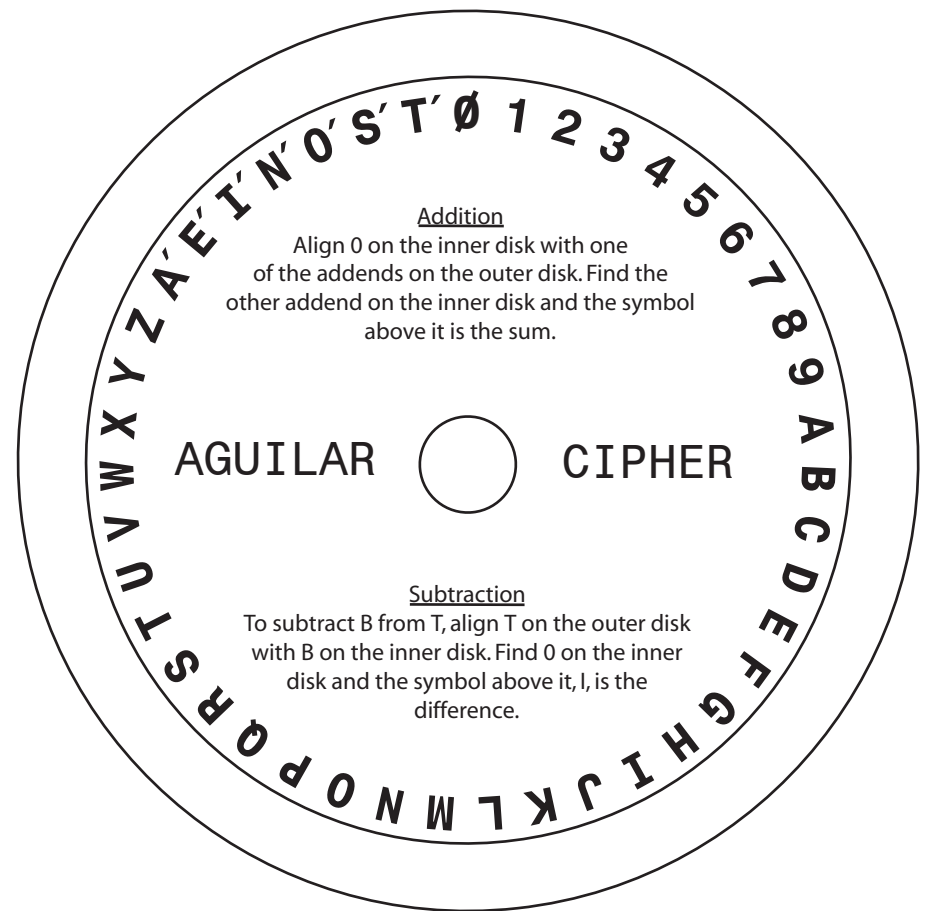


Constructing The Aguilar Cipher Wheel

You will need two AOL CDs (Post Office, grocery store, etc.), scissors, vinyl repair glue (glue aisle in Home Depot), and two brass fittings (Watts part numbers A-734 and A-738, plumbing aisle in Home Depot). Cut out the two 4 1/2" disks below and glue them to the blank side of the AOL CDs, being careful to spread the glue all the way to the edge. Cut off the rim around the smaller disk and bolt them together with the female fitting downwards. Cut off the strip at the edge of the page and tape it to your computer monitor to help calculate the check sum.
